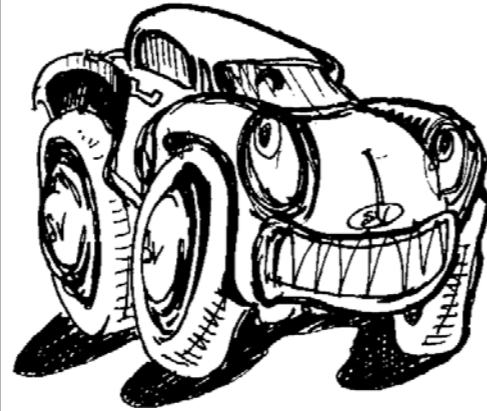

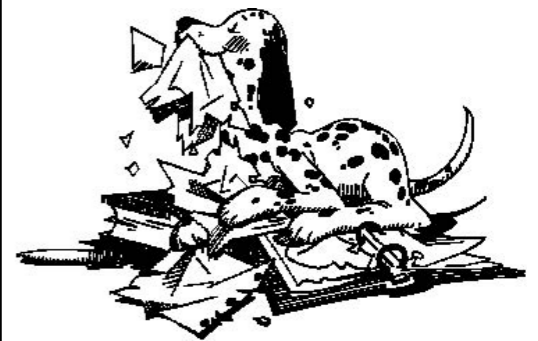


**My Penguin**
